Trials include seeds of both cultivars for approximately 8-10 row feet or 3-5 containers per cultivar

- 1. Bean, bush snap (Buff Valentine, Magnum)- raised bed
- 2. Bean, pole (Kentucky Blue, Seychelles)
- 3. Okra, dwarf (Baby Bubba, Dwarf long green pod)- raised bed
- 4. Cucumber, vining slicer (Gateway, Eversweet)
- 5. Cucumber, burpless (Tasty Green, Tendergreen)
- 6. Tomato, det. slicer (Better Bush, Homeslice)- container/raised bed
- 7. Zucchini, green (Emperor's Jade, Safari)
- 8. Zucchini, compact (Bush Baby, Golden Star)- container/raised bed
- 9. Winter squash, storage (Blue Ballet hubbard, Tahitian butternut)
- 10. Herb, basil (Dark Opal, Prospera Red, Winner) – container/raised bed
- 11. Herb (cool season), dill (Fernleaf, Teddy)- container/raised bed
- 12. Sunflower, dwarf (Firecracker, Teddy Bear)- container/raised bed
- 13. Zinnia, for cutting garden (Benery Giant Mix, Cactus Mix)
- 14. Cool season, beet (Touchstone Gold, Zeppo) - container/raised bed
- 15. Cool season, kale (Black Magic, Prizm) - container/raised bed
- 16. Youth Trial- snacker cucumber (Diva, Mini Me)- container or raised bed if trellised (free for those participating in other trials)
